I am requesting funding for completion of the Daniel Webster Park in fiscal year 2022.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Albuquerque, located at 1 Civic Plaza, Albuquerque, New Mexico, 87102.

The funding would be used to complete Phases 3 and 4 of Daniel Webster Park, named after an Albuquerque police officer, shot and killed in the line of duty. Federal funds will be used for construction, including site preparation, creation of green spaces and installation of play equipment and innovative features that comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) that will serve children with a wide range of ability challenges. No park of this type exists in Albuquerque. Completion of Daniel Webster Par will improve and support economic development in an under-served neighborhood. Daniel Webster Park will be an example to the nation of how to lift people up through parks, bring them together and create a more just and equitable society and communities.
