The entity to receive funding for this project is the Indian Pueblo Cultural Center, located at 2401 12th Street NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico, 87104.

The funding would be used to complete the IPOC and IPK and further the mission of the Indian Pueblo Cultural Center. The Indian Pueblo Cultural Center has been honoring New Mexico's Pueblos since 1976. The IPCC is owned and operated by the 19 Pueblos and provides a unique educational experience to the thousands of visitors each year. The IPCC includes a 10,000 square foot museum of the history and artifacts of traditional Pueblo cultures and their contemporary art for more than 40 years. The Indian Pueblo Kitchen and the Indian Pueblo Opportunity Center are two projects designed with the IPCC's core mission in mind: to preserve and perpetuate Pueblo culture while providing opportunities for the Pueblo people to better their lives.
