

Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

“I am requesting funding for City of Albuquerque Youth Shelter in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is The City of Albuquerque, located at 1 Civic Plz #10, Albuquerque, NM, 87102. The \$3,000,000.00 of funding would be used to provide a safe, transitional environment for homeless and unstably housed youth. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because of the return on investment it will provide to the community. The Campus will house about 30 young people at a time, and over 120 young people a year. Additionally, the campus will provide services and supports to young people experiencing homelessness or housing instability. Through this model, the facility will serve hundreds of youth per year. The young people served in this facility will receive support to become self-sustaining, productive members of the community, which benefits the whole community. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
