
I am requesting funding for Home Rehabilitation Program in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is County of Bernalillo, located at 415 Silver Ave. SW, Albuquerque, NM 87102-3225. The funding would be used for the rehabilitation of homes occupied by income qualified homeowners located in all areas of Bernalillo County.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it represents a responsible and cost-effective use of taxpayer funds by preserving existing affordable housing and preventing far more expensive public interventions in the future. By addressing critical health and safety repairs—such as faulty electrical systems, leaking roofs, and accessibility barriers—this program ensures that low- and moderate-income homeowners can continue to live safely in their homes, reducing the risk of displacement and homelessness.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. § 5301 et seq.), which permits housing rehabilitation and related activities to improve health and safety, preserve affordable housing, and benefit low- and moderate-income households.
