Number of total individuals being detained or incarcerated at TCDF: 114

Number of individuals in USMS custody: 39 (36 males, 3 females)

Number of individuals in Torrance County custody: 48 (43 males, 5 females)

Number of ICE detainees: 25

Notes: On August 16, ICE transferred 28 detainees from the El Paso Processing Center to TCDF.
