Number of total individuals being detained or incarcerated at TCDF: 122

Number of individuals in USMS custody: 45 (42 males, 3 females)

Number of individuals in Torrance County custody: 53 (47 males, 6 females)

Number of ICE detainees: 21

Notes: On August 16, ICE transferred 28 detainees from the El Paso Processing Center to TCDF.
