
I am requesting funding for Young Adult Housing Expansion-Phase 2 in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of Albuquerque - Health, Housing, and Homelessness Department, located at 1 Civic Pl NW, Albuquerque, NM 87102. The funding would increase the supply of safe, stable housing specifically designed for transition-age youth while connecting residents with supportive services that promote long-term housing success. By addressing homelessness early in adulthood, the project helps prevent chronic homelessness, reduces reliance on emergency systems, and strengthens the community's broader strategy to improve housing stability for vulnerable young people.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will benefit low- and moderate-income individuals and strengthen communities by expanding access to safe, stable housing. Expanding housing options for this population improves housing stability for low-income young adults while strengthening the community's broader efforts to prevent chronic homelessness and support successful transitions to adulthood.

The project is authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
